Teddy Bears Picnic EYFS

Venture through our magical woodland looking for the Tanglewood Teddies! A beautiful half or full day of story telling and fun activities based on how woodland animals survive.

Key concepts: Imagination, speaking and listening, creativity, social skills and understanding of the natural world





Enchanted Woods EYFS/KS1

Did you know Tanglewood has magical fairies and dragons? Come and search our woodland for a very cheeky dragon and discover the other mythical creatures of Cannock Chase. Dragons, fairies, boggatts....what more could you ask for?

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Living History Days! KS2

Our Living History days focus on Stone age, Ancient Greeks, Romans, Anglo Saxons and Vikings.

Bring your school to Cannock Chase and travel back in time.

Hunt for woolly mammoths, build a Viking longship, discover the history of ancient Greeks and Anglo Saxons or become a Roman solider.

Key concepts: Survival, teamwork, problem solving, communication skills, co-operation, materials, habitats





Team Building KS2

This session is ideal as an "end of year" forest fun day or even to bond your class at the start of a new academic year, and don't forget a perfect excuse to shake off SATS. You can also mash up team building with survival skills, from den building to sensory games or races to puzzle solving. This is a day everyone will enjoy, whatever the weather!

Habitats! KS2

An in-depth look at a woodland throughout the year. Walk through our woods identifying trees, plants and animal signs. Search for animal habitats and learn about the importance of hibernation, germination and pollination! After lunch enjoy seasonal art and activities.

Key concepts: Habitats, hibernation, germination and pollination, tree identification, care of the environment, food chains




Tangle up!
